Seat allocation

All Supporters' priority bookings received before the opening dates are pooled, with tickets for each performance being distributed randomly among the 'early birds'. Once booking has opened, orders are dealt with in order of arrival.

St Magnus Cathedral is a wonderful building but it is not a concert hall. We hope audiences will agree that the lack of perfect sightlines is more than compensated for by the special ambience.

For Cathedral performances reserved seats are allocated starting from the front of the Nave.

Once all the reserved Nave seats are used, unreserved tickets are allocated for seats in the transepts and side aisles.

We will do our best to satisfy seating requests at all venues.

Festival transport
